

# Ontario Association of Public Health Nursing Leaders is Seeking Expression of Interest: Website and Social Media Strategy

### **PURPOSE**

The Ontario Association of Public Health Nursing Leaders (hereinafter referred to as OPHNL) is seeking expression of interest (EOI) for the development/redevelopment of the OPHNL website and social media strategy.

## **BACKGROUND**

OPHNL members are public health nurses employed at the management level across Ontario. Formed in 2015, the association is the combined voice for two original groups: (a) the Association of Nursing Directors, Supervisors of Official Health Agencies, and (2) the Chief Nursing Officers Group.

This project will be to develop/redevelop the OPHNL website and social media strategy that communicates the vision, mission, and strategic plan of the association, provides information relevant to public health nursing leaders; and attracts new members to the association.

Currently OPHNL has a twitter account and two websites: (a) <a href="www.ophnl.org">www.ophnl.org</a> is the public facing website, (b) the members only section is hosted on wildapricot.org.

NOTE: Two separate projects are currently planned/underway and are linked to but out of scope for this project. These projects include: (a) OPHNL Strategic Direction, and (b) Recovery and Reimagining Public Health with Nursing Leaders.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

This project will be to develop a website and social media strategy for OPHNL that clearly articulates the vision, mission and strategic direction of the association, provides information relevant to public health nursing leaders; and attracts new members to the association.

# Objectives:

- 1. Meet with OPHNL Executive Committee members to discuss and confirm content and features to include on website and communication objectives for social media strategy.
- 2. External facing website that is user friendly, leverages other multi-media platforms and clearly communicates (1) the vision, mission and strategic plan of the association, and (2) information relevant to public health nursing leaders.
- 3. Internal facing online platform to allow communication and document sharing between association members
- 4. Social media strategy
